"I am Pastor Kanikai Doss from Ellupur village, Pudukkottai District. I have a small congregation of 19 families within 30 km radius. My daughter's family lives with us. Since the nationwide lockdown from March 25th because of the Covid-19 pandemic, we are going through a terrible food crisis, nobody is able to go outside his house, every non-essential shop is closed, grocery shops are closed or not very well supplied. We did not have time to go to the bank and withdraw some money. However, we never lost our hope in prayers. It was, indeed, a miracle our Lord Jesus sent us the team from Eternal Word Ministries to our house to deliver one-week grocery stuff including rice. it is true our Lord is the Provider! Our Joy overflows! Like us so many Pastors and native missionaries are struggling for food and wonder how they can survive. After these 3 weeks, the lockdown is now again extended until May 3rd. We are very thankful to Pastor John and EWM Team and are praying the Lord to work through them more and more for meeting desperate needs of so many pastors and native missionaries."
